Call for Papers

You are welcome to send your research abstract to the 1st International Video Conference on Social Sciences - 2018 (IVCSS – 2018) on the Theme of “GLOBALIZATION AND ITS IMPACT ON SOCIETY” being held on **May 04, 2018** (Friday) with the collaboration of Society for Social Sciences & Research Association (SSSARA) and Benazir Bhutto Shaheed University (BBSU) Karachi.

The research in social sciences focuses the issues of society and identifies their root causes. Covering a variety of disciplines, social sciences provide insights to the particular fields. Therefore, you as a researcher, academician, social worker, policy maker or other stakeholder are welcome to submit your original research paper to the first International Video Conference on Social Sciences – 2018. Before submission of your research paper send its abstract not more than 250 words.

All research papers will be selected on the basis of double blind peer reviewed process. The research papers to present in the conference must be in a prescribed format. In IVCSS – 2018, all sessions will be held through video link while the researchers from Karachi will have the opportunity to present their paper at the conference venue. Only the registered users can access the sessions.

The research papers presented in the conference will be published in the relevant research journals of SSSARA which are mainly based on International Relations / Politics, Education and Islamic Studies. Certificates will be awarded to the presenters and all of the participations as a token of appreciation. The proceedings of the conference can be access through website.

Sub-Themes of the Conference

Your topic of interest for submission should be within the scope of following Sub-Themes:

- i) Globalization and International Relations
 - ii) Globalization and its impact on Education
 - iii) Globalization and its impact on Islam
- or any topic related to the Conference Theme and Sub-Themes

Objectives of the Conference

- Participate in exploratory and academic debates and leave the conference with new perspectives and the impact of globalization in society.

- Connect the researchers across the world and enrich engagement with colleagues and peers.

Abstract Submission

Following is the criteria for abstract submission:

- Mention theme of the conference with sub-theme
- Article's Title
- Author's Name, designation, Institute of affiliation, Email ID and contact number
- Abstract of 250 words in English Language

Criteria for Article Submission

The article must be in English language and in the form of research paper including:

- Author's Name, designation, Institute of affiliation, Email ID and contact number.
- Article's Title
- Abstract of 250 words
- Keywords
- Accomplished empirical or theoretical research based on mentioned sub-themes, employing qualitative or quantitative methods.
- Conclusion &/or Recommendations
- References in APA 6th Edition.
- **Format:** Times New Roman Style, Font size 12, single line space
- **Length of Paper:** Since the articles will be published in the research journals of SSSARA, therefore, length of research paper must be according to the criteria of relevant research journal which is as follows:
 - i) 5000 to 8000 words for the sub-theme 'Globalization and International Relations'
 - ii) Maximum 4000 words for the sub-theme 'Globalization and its impact on Education'
 - iii) Maximum 8000 words for the sub-theme 'Globalization and its impact on Islam'

Guideline for Presentation

Presentation must be in PowerPoint. Time for presentation is 10 to 15 minutes. It should include:

- Article's Title
- Introduction
- Methodology
- Conclusion
- Implications / Recommendations for policy/practice

Who should attend?

Groups or individuals, particularly those with a concern for marginalized issues with respect to their fields will be encouraged in this conference.
