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INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

- The Examination will be held on the dates, during the hours and at the place according to the program previously notified by the Controller of Examinations. The doors of the Examination Hall will be opened half an hour before the Examination time on the first day and ten minutes on the subsequent dates and will close punctually at the time fixed for the commencement of the Examination after which no candidate will be admitted except with the special permission of the Head-Invigilator, No candidate will be admitted into the Examination Hall who is late by half an hour.
- No candidate shall be admitted into the Examination Hall without the prescribed Admit Card and Enrolment Card, issued by the University and Identity Card with a photograph duly attested by the Principal of the College or the Head of the Department concerned. Candidates are liable to expulsion from the Examination Hall for failure to produce the University Admit Card, the Enrolment Card and the Identity Card.
- Candidates are forbidden to carry into the examination Hall or have in their possession while under Examination, any books, notes, papers, writings, scribbling or any other material other than the Admit Card, Enrolment Card, Identity Card, writing requisites, drawing or Mathematical instruments. For any contravention of this rule they are liable to expulsion from the Hall.
